Established in 1849, Champagne Pol Roger remains family owned and proudly independent to this day. The history and spirit of the company mirrors that of the family who bear the name; a respect for nature, a devotion to quality and a certain *Joie de vivre*.

As one of the smaller houses, Champagne Pol Roger owns 87 hectares of vineyards on prime sites in the Vallee d'Epernay and the Côtes de Blancs. Its cellars, extending to 7km, lie on 3 levels in the chalk below Epernay and are among the deepest and coolest cellars in the regions, contributing to the slow maturation and creation of fine, persistent bubbles which are the hallmark of all Pol Roger Champagnes.

Sir Winston Churchill was Pol Roger's most illustrious devotee and customer. The Pol Roger Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill was made in his honour. The composition of the blend is a closely guarded family secret but from tasting it is likely that the Champagne features about 70-80% Pinot Noir with the remainder made up from Chardonnay. The grapes are all from Grand Cru vineyards which were under vine during Churchill's lifetime and is only ever made in the very best vintages. It is made in a style which Churchill himself favoured; robust, mature and long lived.

29	<b>Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV</b> A nose of delicate white flowers and brioche, with appealing and complex nose of a fresh, lively palate showing good balance, creamy texture and great depth. Made from Pinot Noir, contributing body and depth; Chardonnay, giving lightness, elegance and finesse; and Pinot Meunier for youthful freshness, vigour and plump fruit character.	£46.00 Glass £8.00
30	<b>Pol Roger Rich NV</b> A lovely yellow gold colour with creamy bubbles. The nose is forward and elegant with notes of dried fruits, fresh cut flowers and spicy vanilla. In the mouth the wine is soft and balanced with hints of spice, fruit and caramel. The finish is long, complex and very pleasant. The 'rich' style does not imply a cloying, syrupy style of Champagne, there is a touch of sweetness and is beautifully balanced by a natural, fresh acidity. Ideal with desserts.	£46.00
31	<b>Pol Roger Brut Vintage 1999</b> Bright, intensely golden, the nose starts with a bouquet of roses, and as it warms up toasted notes appear, mainly brioche, a combination of delicacy and smoothness. As it unfolds, the mouth develops candied, yellow fruit, quince and marzipan, with a beautifully delicate, smooth and sensual touch.	£66.00
32	<b>Pol Roger Brut Chardonnay 1996</b> A light, lively colour with fine bubbles, complex aromas on the nose of marshmallow, violets, liquorice, toast and almonds. In the mouth, the bold attack develops into a balance of fullness and strength, dominated by fresh fruitiness, underpinned by a groundswell of power.	£78.00
33	<b>Pol Roger Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill 1998</b> An intense creamy mousse and an elegant, floral bouquet as well as notes of dried fruits. On the palate, it is broad, rich and stylish, with great balance between the force and richness of Pinot Noir and the finesse and delicacy of Chardonnay.	£145.00
34	<b>Pol Roger Vintage Rosé 2000</b> Intense, brilliant pink colour, a powerful bouquet with citrus fruit aromas recalling blood orange, grapefruit and blackcurrant purée with Turkish Delight. In the mouth there is a balance between a lively attack, developing toward minerality and finesse.	£80.00
